 - o Derek has hotline

 - Spoke to half a dozen people for district history. Many have agreed to give a history.
 - Dean has history forms to distribute to the longer standing members to fill out for Manistique area
 - o This information goes into the Area 74 book
- Conference/Assembly Planning:
 - Munising Building has been reserved for Conference dates, Alger Parks and Recreation

Business:

- Radio PSAs:
 - They will run PSAs for us. They will run a couple times a day, a couple days a week for several months. Not a very defined schedule.
 - o They can do a single station
 - o They can do all the stations in the network
 - o They can read text we give them
 - o Dean provided standardize text which Neal transcribed from GSO
 - O They will read a phone number at the end
 - o Must be less than 30 seconds

- O Dean recommends just starting in Manistique area so not stepping on anyones toes.
- o Houghton, Marquette and Escanaba are in their network which is outside of our district.
- o Dean will check about the Newberry station being part of the network.
- At the next intergroup, Dean suggested talking with the other district committee members about their feelings on radio PSAs.
- Voted and approved to start a PSA in Manistique only.
- O <u>Action Item</u>: Please review the PSAs provided via email by Dean and Neal and select your favorite PSA verbiage. Be prepared to discuss at next meeting to vote on what message will be played in Manistique.
- Group Numbers:
 - o Dean will make some inquiries and see how this is being handled.

New Business:

- 2016 Workshop
 - o Sponsorship suggested for next workshop topic. Voted and approved.
 - o Next month we should look at picking out dates
- Review of 2015 Workshop:
 - o About 30 people there. Well under budget. Looking at Johnny Dawgs to cater the Area Conference.
- Freedom Voice Hotline
 - o 9.95 per month or 8.96 per month
 - o Forwards calls to multiple groups or Round Robin process
 - o We can forward our existing number for no charge
 - o We can get a new number
 - Auto attendant which can differentiate between the purpose of the call and routing to the appropriate number
 - Menu for caller, press one for... Press two for.... What if they press nothing?
 - o Customized on hold message
 - o Activity can be tracked with very specific parameters.
 - O Audio files can be sent/forwarded as emails
 - o All numbers can have their own voice mailbox
 - o We're currently spending \$120 per month on our Tracfone hotline.
 - o Might be worth exploring this option when current plan expires
 - o If you pay by check, there are some hoops to jump through. If paid by credit card it's simpler.
 - o There is a free trial period that can be used for testing the service
 - o Group meeting should be held to discuss who would be willing to be a contact for their area
 - o Marquette is considering using this as their hotline also
 - o Write up going in Now and Then about this opportunity with Internet Phone.

• Discounts on Literature from Area 74 -

o Shipping costs are very high for individual groups/districts. Area 74 has a literature committee. The committee chair pools all the district orders together for discounts. New Literature chair is coming in January.
